Elizabeth Eloise (Brown) Johnson, was born in New York City on February 4th 1922. She was the daughter of the late Deacon John Lacy Brown and Deaconess Bessie Irene (Hicks) Brown.

Betty as she was known to others, grew up in Hackensack, New Jersey. She was saved accepting our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ as her personal savior at an early age.

In 1938, Betty rendered a piano selection over New York City Radio Station W.O.V. at the age of sixteen as a student of the New York School of Music. She graduated from Hackensack High School, Class of 1939, and was married the following June 1940 to Richard Ernest Johnson of Hackensack in Elkton, Maryland. From this union, they were blessed with two children, Marvin E. Johnson of South Orange, New Jersey and Marlene E. Holmes of Rutherford, New Jersey. Richie and Betty lived briefly in Hackensack before moving to Rutherford in 1943.

Betty retired in 1986 from Flex-Brockway of Carlstadt, New Jersey after twenty-seven years of service. During the fifties and sixties, Betty was the pianist for the Physical Education classes in the Rutherford School System and also Miss Debby's Dance School in Northern New Jersey.

Betty served as an organist of the New Christian Missionary Baptist Church in Paterson, New Jersey, New Hope Baptist Church in Hackensack, New Jersey, John Wesley Methodist Church in East Rutherford, New Jersey and was Organist Emeritus at Mt. Ararat Baptist Church in



Rutherford where she had played for nearly forty years. Betty also played for the Early Morning Praise Service at the church until September of 2016, at the rightful age of 94.

Betty also played in the 1950's as the accompanist for Dramatic Soprano, Isabelle Waldron of East Rutherford

whose voice resonated in music halls and churches of New Jersey and New York like the sound of Marian Anderson.

Many people of the Rutherford community knew Betty as gifted in music, personable and giving in her life's spirit.

Heaven opened its doors and God dispatched an angel to give Elizabeth Eloise Johnson a personal escort from Alaris-Health Care in Rochelle Park, New Jersey to her heavenly home at 7:44 a.m. on Monday, February 27th, 2017 at the age of 95.

She was predeceased by her husband, Deacon Richard Johnson, her son and daughter-in-law, Donald J. Holmes and Sandra E. Johnson.
