The family relocated to Paterson, NJ where he attended the Paterson School System. He was employed with DPW for eighteen years.

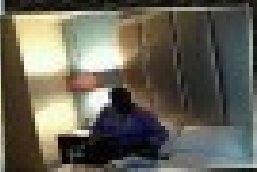
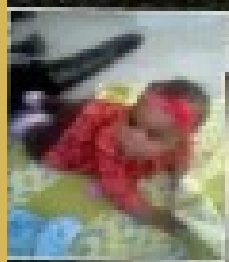
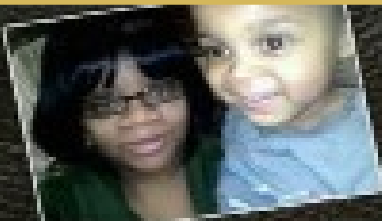
