Reflections of Life

Donald Carlos, better known as DD to family and friends was born in Paterson, New Jersey on November 29, 1958. DD was the youngest son of the late RoseMarie Eason Carlos and the late Herbert Eugene Carlos.

A product of the Paterson Public Schools, he graduated of Eastside High School and matriculated to Fairleigh Dickerson University (Teaneck), receiving a Bachelor's of Science degree in Business.

After working for an advertising company in New York City his love of travel got the best of him so he relocated to Denver, Colorado and lived in the Big Sky Country. He later returned to Paterson and its proximity to New York City and its many concerts. DD especially loved Diana Ross and was often in attendance at her concerts and had an extensive collection of her recordings.

Again overcome by his longing to see new places, DD relocated to Georgia, living in various cities while traveling to the Bahamas and other interesting places.

While in Georgia he suffered a stroke which left him partially paralyzed and unable to speak clearly. DD was cared for by his only sister, Carol until her death this past May. Unable to live alone, DD's nephew Kevin traveled to Georgia and returned him to Paterson thus becoming his caregiver.

DD was called to glory on Saturday, March 11, 2017.

DD was predeceased by his loving parents, a brother, Herbert Eugene Carlos, Jr. and his sister, Carol Carlos.
