Hesikiah “Robbie” Robinson passed on April 02, 2017 at the age of 69. Hesikiah was born on September 15, 1947 to the late Hezekiah Robinson, Sr. and Geneva (Riggs) Robinson in Tallulah, Louisiana. He was the oldest of twelve children.
