Obituary

Daniel Adewale Adebisi was born on September 9, 1984 at St. Mary's Hospital in Passaic, NJ. Wale grew up in Passaic, NJ with aspirations of becoming an actor. His first job was a paper route at age 12, and by age 13 he outsourced the route to his friends for a fraction of his wages while he picked up another job at a local car wash. At 15 years old Wale began buying and selling cars independently where he earned the reputation of being the "car guy" and developed his art of negotiating. In 2003, he graduated from Passaic County Technical Institute a vocational high school in Wayne, NJ where he studied computer repair.

After high school Wale attended Bergen Community College in Paramus, NJ to study business management. After one semester, he dropped out of college after realizing that none of his business professors ever owned or operated their own business. He told his father "how can they teach me about business if they never owned one?" Wale then decided to get his real estate license instead, and learned all that he could about buying and selling homes.

As he pursued his real estate license, he simultaneously got a job at EZ pass's corporate office in Newark, NJ where he worked and saved up his money. In 2005 Wale got his real estate license. Two years later at the age of 23 he purchased his first home in Linden, NJ. One year after purchasing his home, in 2008 Wale purchased his first business, a Laundromat at the age of 25. He named it Danny's Laundromat.

Wale left his job at EZ pass shortly after and dedicated all his time and energy into growing his business often working long hours. From his mid-twenties and on Wale would go to sell and acquire additional businesses and real estate through the Tri-state area until his passing. Daniel Adewale Adebisi, entered into His Heavenly House April 2, 2017.

Wale is best known for his charisma, energy, sense of humor, empathy & outspokenness. Some of Wale's sayings were:

"Have to take chances in life and jump out the window"

"Everything is negotiable"

"Got to be your own man"
