How did Darlene enter our lives? Naturally in a very off-beat way...because she danced to the beat of a different drum. Like the music she loved, Darlene was eclectic. She had a sense of style and a flourish that was all her own- an original. Some people have to exaggerate a person's legacy- Darlene lived that exaggeration, that dream for which many women strive. To be a caregiver for their husband and children, to maintain your friendships, and to enjoy your life.


