whispered 'Come with me.'

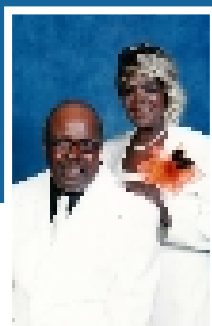
He suffered much in silence,
