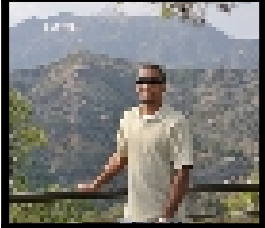


Reflections of Life
