Anna Makomis Taliaferro was called to be with the Lord on Thursday, August 10, 2017, at the age of 79 in Norfolk, Virginia. She was born and raised on August 28, 1937 in Mount Vernon and the Bronx, NY to the late Samuel N. Gillian, Sr. and Alma Lee Gillian.

She was best known as Mother T, Ma T, Dr. T, Lady T, Ms. T, Anna T, Nana, Nana Banana, and Grandma/Granny. She was loved and respected Nationally, Statewide and Locally by so many for her passion of children, education and her community, which was shown through her dedication and commitment to serving those who sought her expertise/advise and moreover her compassion and being the Queen of the Village.

Anna began her career in 1964, as a Follow Thru Parent, Title III, Title I and Concerned Parents for Head Start and thus becoming the 1st Parent Coordinator in the State of New Jersey for the Paterson Public School Title III Program, ultimately beginning her lifelong era of fighting for Education.

She was the recipient of many awards, citations and plaques to name a few, specifically the "Phenomenal Woman" award. The Howard Seeley Queen Mother Award, "Woman of the Year" award, Queen of the Village Award, and recognition for 30 years of Outstanding Service to Education as well as an award for New Jersey Association for Parent Coordinators, Inc. for Leadership and Dedication in addition to receiving the "Fannie Lou Hamer" Award.
