His education began at San Fernando Boys RC School. Them on to presentation College where he was a star football player. He migrated to the USA in 1955 to further his studies at Indiana University for Engineering. He did his graduate studies at Stanford University in California. He was a registered certified civil Engineer Recognized both in the States of California and New York.

Ravel leaves behind: his big sister, Vienna Medford; his two brothers, Theodore and Bennett; his son, Andre; and a host of nieces and nephews as well as a great nieces and nephews, lots of friends as a well as his life long friend, Leary Solomon.
