Denise was born July 25, 1962, the third child of Elouise Turner and the late Oliver Ervin.

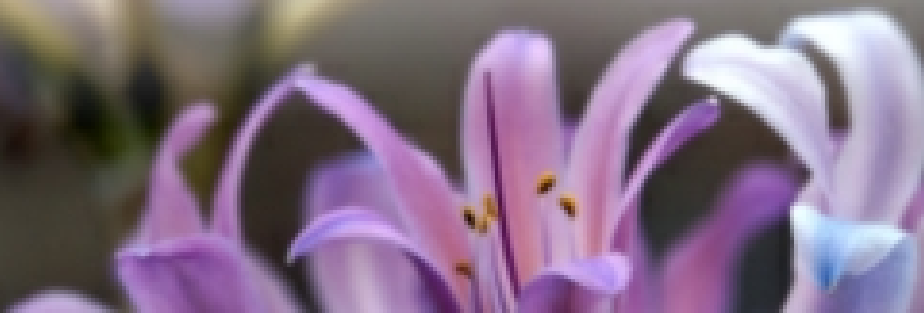
