## Obituary

**Lorenzo Rosario Daley**, affectionately known as “Tega”, “Tigg” or “Teega Weega” was born to Denine Kerr and Carlton Daley on March 22, 1988 at Jubilee Hospital in Kingston, Jamaica. Growing up, he was a kind, fun, loving child who was comical and made everyone around him laugh. He loved to pray as a child and would often be seen praying over his mother’s bad knees for healing. He and his mother shared an inseparable bond as she raised him as a single parent. Life was difficult at times for the pair, but with God in the vessel they weathered the storm together.

Lorenzo migrated to the United States with his grandmother in October 1995 where he resided in Florida for a very short period of time before moving with his mother to Mount Vernon, New York. They returned to Florida a year later but ultimately moved back to New York in October 1997. At nine (9 years old), Lorenzo accepted Jesus Christ as his personal Lord and Savior and would hold fast to that decision throughout his life. He was always fascinated by the military and at one point wanted to join the army. He unfortunately was unable to fulfill that dream. We all know that Lorenzo was not known as a big man in terms of physical stature, but he was a big man in other areas. He had a big sense of humor, a big heart, he was big on being a good son and a good brother, big on being a good husband; he certainly left a big impact on those he loved.

On August 1, 2015, Lorenzo took a huge step in his adult journey when he married DeAsia Maxine Lampkin. He often said marriage was spiritual and so no matter what he had to do things the way God said it must be done. And so he loved and honored his wife. The union did not produce any children. Lorenzo was a simple young man, who very much enjoyed nature and the natural simple things in life. As Genesis 3:19 states “For you are dust, and unto dust you shall return”, he embraced elegance and simplicity which would explain his wife’s request to have his final vessel be this eco-friendly container made of purely natural materials so that his body would be returned to the earth that he loved.

On Friday, September 29, 2017, Lorenzo’s light was prematurely extinguished. He died unexpectedly and tragically but we were blessed to have had not only a lifetime with him, but to have experienced and created inextinguishable memories. As Jeremiah 29:11 states: “For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, saith the Lord, thoughts of peace, and not of evil, to give you an expected end.”
