Lucy, known as “Dale” was educated in the Passaic School system. She continued her education becoming a Licensed practical nurse. She was employed by the General Hospital of Passaic for over 30 years before retiring. During her years of service at General Hospital, she received honors and awards for her caring professionalism as a nurse. She received letters of recognition as well as being named Employee of the Month at General Hospital (April 1992) for helping save an employee’s life who was choking.
