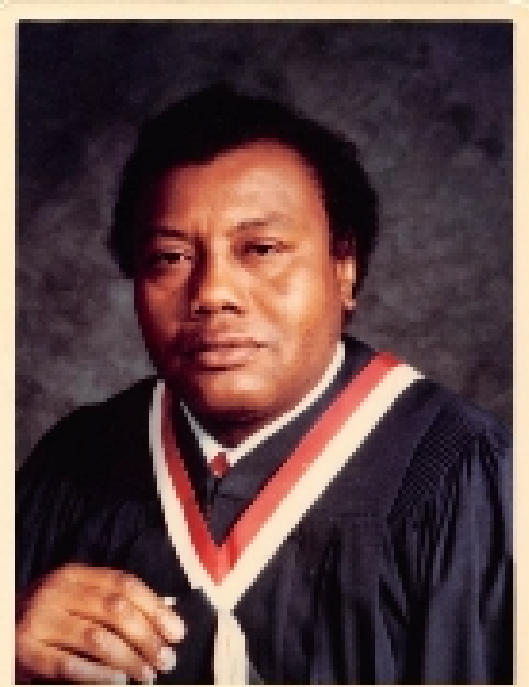

# Reflections of Life

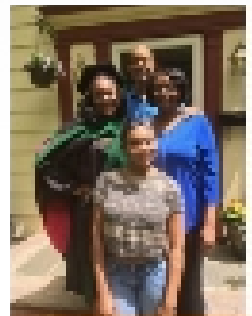
