I could not stay another day. To laugh, to love, to work or play.

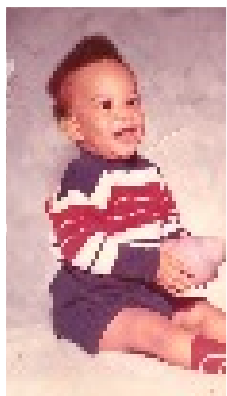
Tasks left undone must stay that way, I found that peace at the close of day. If my parting has left a void, Then fill it up with remembered joy.
