Obituary

Early in the morning on Saturday, January 20, 2018, God sent one of his guardian angels to St. Michael's Hospital in Newark, NJ, to bring home one of his good and faithful servants, **Brother Jeffrey Alan Glover**.

On March 11, 1957, Jeffrey was born in Jersey City, New Jersey to Estelle Glover and the late Fred Glover. Jeffrey was educated in the Jersey City Public School System. He attended P.S. #41 and Henry Snyder High School. He graduated in the Class of 1975. After High School, Jeffrey joined the U.S. Navy. He was honorably discharged in 1979.

On January 25, 1979, Jeffrey welcomed into this world a handsome baby boy, Phillip Glover. On July 11, 1987, Jeffrey married his beautiful wife, Sherri Denise Smith. On January 24, 1991, Jeffrey welcomed his second child, a beautiful daughter, Sha'Quel Alnise Glover.

Jeffrey was employed by the U.S. Postal Service for 35 years, and retired in 2013. On October 21, 1996, he became a member of Masonic Doric Lodge #6 as a Junior Warden – 3rd in command.

He joined Roseville Presbyterian Church in 1998. He was very active and respected, and he worked diligently in the Food Pantry and the Soup Kitchen. He was a part of numerous groups and boards including the Roseville Bowling League, Roseville Men, Men's Usher Team and the Men's Choir under the leadership of Anita Wynn. He served as a Deacon from 2002 to 2005. He later served as an Elder from 2006 to 2012. Jeff also assisted with preparing and cooking for special occasions at Church and by special request. Those who knew him would agree that Jeffrey was a "master chef."

After his retirement, he enjoyed watching his Miami Dolphins' weekly shows, spending time with his furry buddies, Domino (deceased), and "Happy." He also spent his time doing work around the house, cooking, family gatherings, playing on his iPad, and working in his garden. He enjoyed catching up with his two favorite buddies on Sundays – his brother, Kevin Grier, and his Uncle Ronald Glover, both who pre-deceased him.
