Obituary



Charles (CD) Derios, was born on June 30, 1958 in Newark, New Jersey to the late John Derios, Sr. and the late Emma Jane Robinson.

Charles attended Charlton Street Elementary School and graduated from Malcolm X. Shabazz High School in Newark, New Jersey. He then decided to attend Bethune-Cookman University in Daytona Beach, Florida, yet found his true calling at the University of Delaware, where he graduated in 1983 with a Bachelor of Science in Business Administration. He found solace and enjoyment in being a member of Phi Beta Sigma fraternity. He was a charter member of the first line on campus. He was a founder of Chapter number 2 on the line.

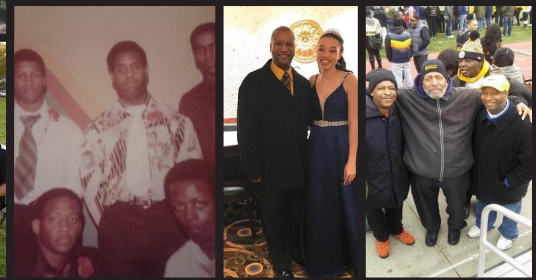
