

Reflections of Life

Jack E. Moore Sr. was born on January 2, 1936, in Aynor, South Carolina. He was the son of the late David and Earlease Moore. Jack was called to rest on Saturday, May 2, 2020, at the Veterans Memorial Home in Paramus, New Jersey. He was 84 years old.

Jack was born and raised in Aynor (Horry County), South Carolina. He attended the local South Carolina school system. Along with his 13 siblings and their parents, they moved to Paterson, NJ. He enlisted in the U.S. Army in 1956 and was stationed at Fort George G. Meade, MD. He was Honorably Discharged from the service in 1962. While in the service, he met and married Estell McCaskill (predeceased). They resided in Paterson, New Jersey with their six children. Jack was formerly a member of Christ Temple Baptist Church in Paterson, NJ, where he served as a Deacon. Jack worked for New Jersey Transit and the Paterson Housing Authority until his retirement.

Jack later married Alice (Ramsey) Moore (predeceased) and continued to reside in Paterson, NJ. Jack was a devoted Deacon of St. Luke Baptist Church, where he served on the Men's Choir. As a servant of the Lord, he renovated the interior of his church home. During Jack's retirement, he took on many different tasks, such as renovating the home where his children were raised, creating a garden in his home, helping his grandson build a bowling lane for his class project, and continuing to do things that made his heart happy.

After the death of his second wife, Jack decided to return to his hometown of South Carolina, where he was reunited with his sister Mattie Lee (predeceased) and other family members. He spent his time using his green thumb to plant a beautiful garden, that he took so much pride in and shared his produce with his neighbors. Years later, Jack was diagnosed with Dementia and moved back to New Jersey. He would remember his life's journey and would tell his story to anyone who would listen. Oh, how he loved to sing, dance, crack jokes, sew and make others smile. Jack was loved by all whom he met and most importantly he was a JACK OF ALL TRADES!
