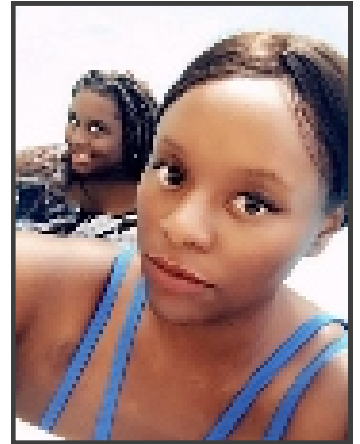

To My Noodles



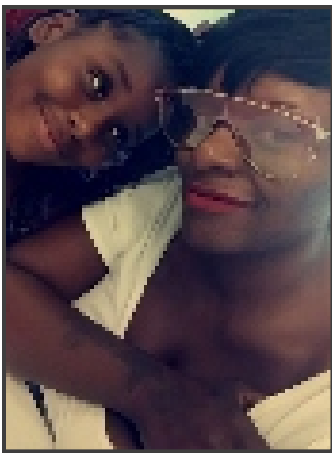
When you walk upon the sand

 In your heart is where I'll be.



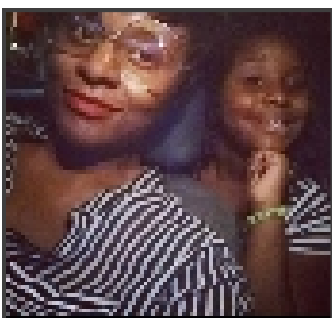
I know it hurts but close your eyes

The Life of Erica Jolene Ashley Wilson

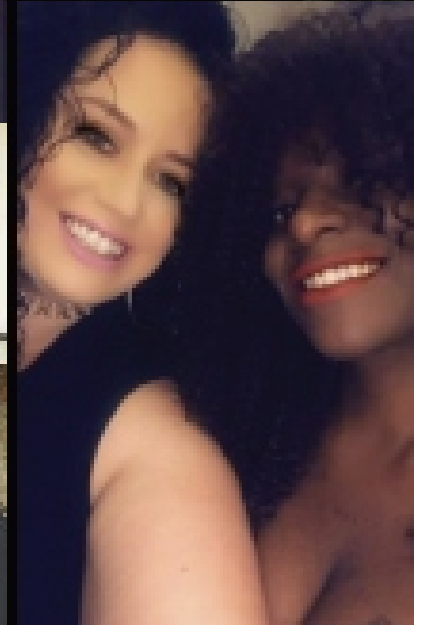
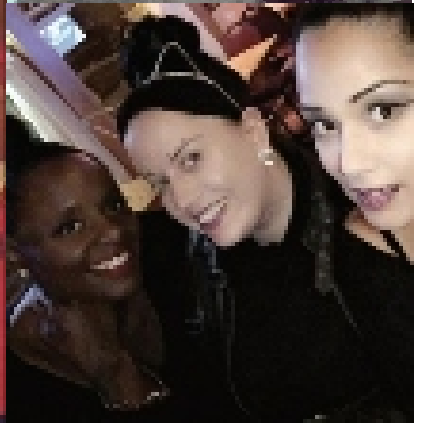
