A Time To Mourn and A Time To Rejoice

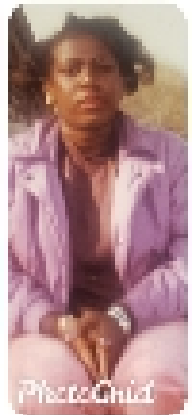
