Obituary

***Rev. Dr. Henry L. Murray, B.S., LL.B. (Law),
LL.M. (Master of law), Doctorate (Theology)***

Dr. Murray (74) was the son of the late Eddie Murray and Lillie Mae Rivers Murray. He was the grandson of the late John and Ada Kelley Murray and the late Willie and Nora Singletary Rivers. Dr. Murray was born on May 1, 1947, in Orangeburg County, SC and departed this life on Thursday, January 20, 2022, in the morning at the VA Hospital in the Bronx, NY. Dr. Murray was preceded in death by his sisters: Nola Mae Wilson and Catherine Adams; brothers: Raymond Murray, Willie Murray, Allen Murray and Benjamin F. Murray; sisters-in-law: Phyllis Ann Elliott Murray; brothers-in-law: Thomas Wilson, Clarence Jones Sr., and Harry Pelzer.

Dr. Murray obtained a B.S. degree in Agribusiness and Economics with a minor in Accounting at South Carolina State College, Orangeburg, S.C. He obtained a law degree from Wolverhampton University at Wolverhampton, UK. He received a LL.M. Master of Law at Touro Law School at Long Island, New York. He received a doctorate in Theology at Lighthouse Seminary at Beebe, Arkansas.

Upon graduation from South Carolina State College in 1970, Dr. Murray joined the United States Marine Corps and attended Officer Candidate School where he was commissioned as a second lieutenant. He completed a single tour of duty in the Marines, which included a year overseas. Dr. Murray was honorably discharged at the rank of captain.

After leaving the military, Dr. Murray joined First National City Bank (Citibank) as a Management Trainee and was promoted to an officer in one year. Dr. Murray left First National City Bank after 4 years and became a special agent with the Federal Bureau of Investigation. He was an FBI agent for a little over ten years and then decided to leave and pursue his dream of being an entrepreneur. He started his own business in real estate and successfully operated as a Real Estate Broker for 35 years.

Dr. Murray was the youngest member of a large family with ten siblings. He grew up in rural South Carolina where he attended public schools and attended church on a regular basis at an early age.

Dr. Murray was a father and husband. He is survived by his wife Joyce R. Horton- Murray and daughter Jocelyn Murray.

Dr. Murray also leaves to cherish his memories, sisters: Geneva Jones of MD, Gertie Pelzer of SC, and Beatrice (Lawrence) Daniels of SC; brother: Edward (Lorraine) Murray of SC; sister-in-law: Dorothy Rush Murray of GA, and a host of nieces, nephews, cousins and friends.
