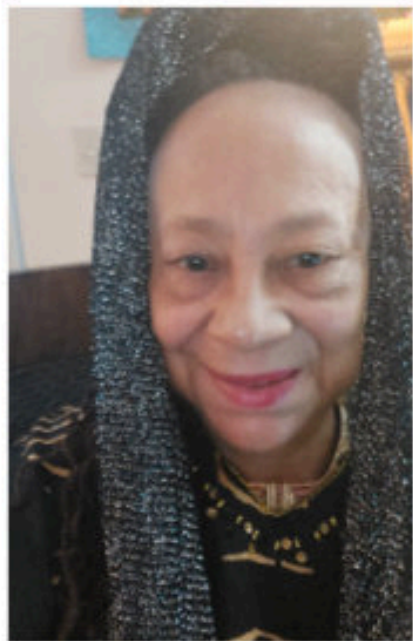

Patricia Hamilton was born on May 7, 1951 in Lugoff, South Carolina. She was the fourth child of the late Gertrude B. Hamilton and Marrinello Hamilton Sr. Patricia found Christ at Bethlehem Baptist Church at an early age. She also received her education in the Kershaw County District.

Affectionately known to many as “Pat”, she later moved to Brooklyn, New York. There Patricia met Alfonso Wyche. God blessed them with one son, Reggie Wyche from that union. She later relocated to the Bronx in Co-Op City Development.

Patricia was eager to expand her education and in December of the late 80's she graduated from The American Academy McAllister Institute of Funeral Service. She also obtained a Bachelor of Arts degree from The College of New Rochelle School of New Resources in 2008. Patricia's dedication led her to attend the Security and Crisis Management Seminar in May 2010 at The Metropolitan College of New York. By May 2011, she pursued a Master of Public Administration in Emergency and Disaster Management. After working for several Funeral Establishments Pat ventured on her own in 2009 and started Serenity Funeral Service and Cremations.

In addition to Patricia's success in the funeral industry, she had an accelerating career in the New York City Board of Education. Patricia worked as a School Aide at Public School 107 and then as a Family Worker receiving the schools Certified Super Hero Award. She also was a School Attendant and later was promoted to a School Attendance Officer working at Public School 24 in Riverdale until her retirement in October 2021.

In 2019, Pat became a devoted member of Beth El House of Yahweh and changed her name to "Nadabayah" and was highly involved in the Hebrew sisterhood.

Patricia had a generous, caring, and loving spirit. She was always helping others, very fashionable, adventurous, and enjoyed nature. Her pleasant personality will truly be missed by everyone she has touched, especially her family and friends who knew and loved her dearly.

On February 14, 2022 at the age of 70, Patricia took her rest. She leaves behind, son Reggie Wyche of Long Island, NY; a grandson of Long Island, NY; one sister Barbara A.
