Born of His Spirit, washed in His blood.

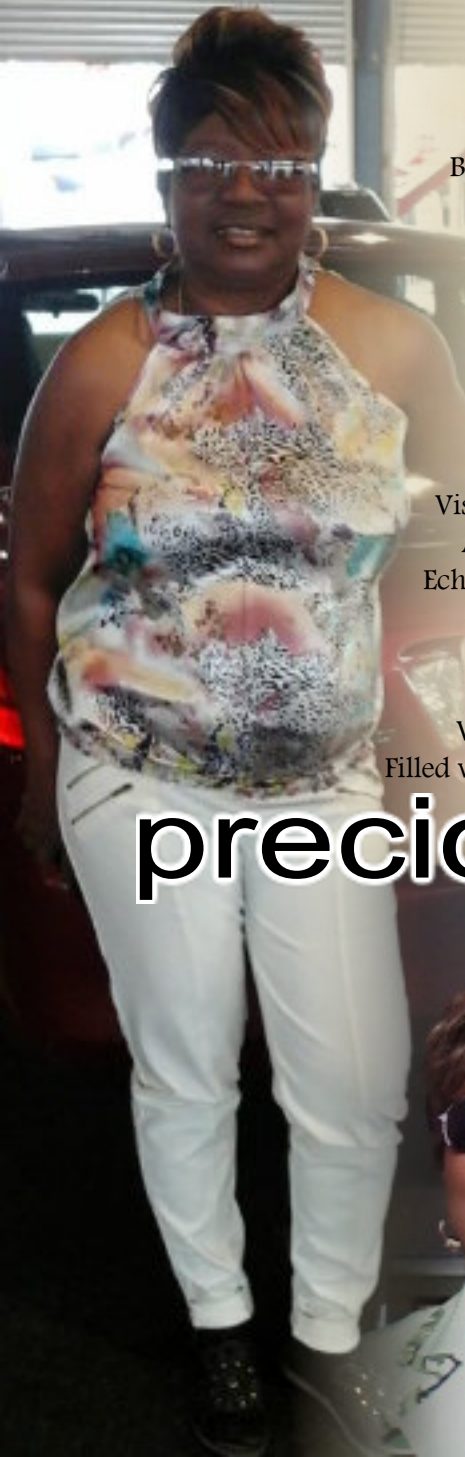
