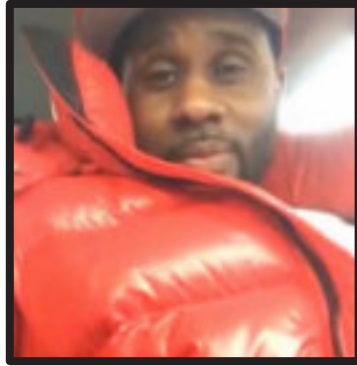

for part of us went with you

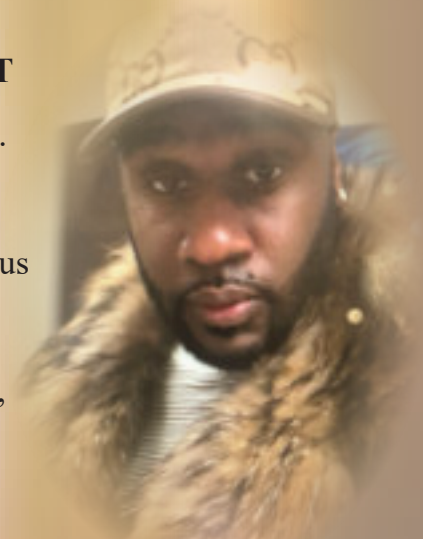
