OBITUARY

Junior George Hall, son of Eugenie Douglas and George Hall, was born on the 29th of October 1956, in Glengoffe, St. Catherine, Jamaica.

Junior grew up in the little district of Elbow where he was raised by his grandmother Miss Ina and his mother Eugenie.

Junior was the first of five children in his family of 3 sisters and 1 brother. Growing up, he attended Grateful Hill Primary School and graduated from Glengoffe Secondary School.

Junior was a God fearing man who regularly attended church and taught Sunday School.

In February 1975, Junior enlisted in the Jamaica Constabulary Force where he received intense training in law and police duties. He graduated from the academy and then transferred to the Kingston Central Police Station. Junior worked the Beat and Foot Patrol and later transferred to Traffic Patrol at Elletson Road.

Junior was an outstanding police officer – always courteous, clean and neat.

In 1977, Junior met and fell in love with Daphne Grandison, also a police officer. In 1987 they exchanged wedding vows in Kingston and their union produced sons Stephen and Junior Hall, Jr.

In 1992, after resigning from the Constabulary Force at the rank of Sargeant, Junior migrated to the United States. While residing in New Jersey, he met and married Tremaine Gordon and from this union, his third son, Maliik Hall was born.

In 2001, Junior joined the Passaic County and later the Essex County Juvenile Detention Centers where he was employed until the time of his passing.

Junior was a good, kind loving, caring and hardworking father. He was all about his family. His beloved grandchildren where the center of his world!

On Wednesday, February 23, 2022, Junior was called from labor to reward. Leaving to celebrate his life and cherish his memory – Daphne and Tremaine; sons Stephen (Chiquira), Junior Hall, Jr., Maliik; stepson Oneil; sisters Vilma, Lorraine, Violet; brother Donovan; grandchildren Stephen Jr., Jayden, Xavier, Janiyla, Leighton and a host of other beloved relatives and friends.
