#### Obituary

**JC Creer** (Jay as he was called) was born on April 5, 1938 in Lauderdale, Mississippi to the late Curtis Creer and Sarah McClain. JC was the sixth child born out of seven children, and was the baby boy.

JC attended school in Mississippi. He migrated from Mississippi to New York at an early age and worked in the trucking industry. He later joined the Creer family construction business working together with his father and other family members until he retired.

JC loved his family and was always there to help in time of need. He also had a love for cars and was very knowledgeable about them. He was a hard worker who would start his day at 5:00 am in the morning and work until the end of the day. In 1955, JC met the love of his life Althea Wallace. They courted and later married on June 22, 1963. A union that has lasted for 57 years.

In December 2018, JC became ill and had a massive stroke. He was treated at Metropolitan Hospital in Manhattan and after a very slow recovery was transferred to the Split Rock Nursing Home and Rehabilitation Center in the Bronx. While there, he suffered further health issues that were stroke-related and resulted in the amputation of his right leg. JC was never one for pity, but continued to be his normal self, humorous and friendly to all he met. JC succumbed to his illness on March 17, 2022 and was not strong enough to pull through.

He is preceded in death by his parents, Mr. Curtis Creer and Mrs. Sarah Creer, three sisters: Viola (Sue) Young, Willie Mae Richardson; Clara Mae Boyd; two brothers: William Curtis (Sam) Creer, Howard Creer; one son Bobbie and one daughter Sharon (Ronnie).

JC leaves to cherish his memories, his beloved wife, Althea Creer, one sister, Catherine Cook (Polly), one Sister-in-law, Novella Wallace and two Son-in-laws Ronnie and Richard. 3 Children: Akbar (Leslie), Alphonso (Gloria), Yolanda (Richard); 12 grandchildren, 12 great grandchildren, and 2 great-great grandchildren, and a host of nieces, nephews, family and friends.
