In the beauty of the day now consumed in eternity, Marie (Myra) Alberta Jeremiah-Nicholas was born on September 24, 1950 to the late Hilton and Alice Mary Jeremiah in Old Road Village, Antigua. She was affectionately known as “Myra” by her family and friends growing up in Antigua and most of her adult life in the U.S Virgin Islands.

Marie attended Old Road Public School System in Antigua. At an early age, she joined St. Mary’s Episcopal Church in Antigua where she was dedicated as an infant and received confirmation during her teenage years. There, she was a member of Sunday School, Youth Choir and Youth Fellowship Ministries.

Marie migrated to St. Croix, U.S. Virgin Islands in 1968 and married her high school sweetheart, Randolph Nicholas in 1969. She later moved to St. Thomas U.S. Virgin Islands with her husband where they resided for many years and raised their two children.
