She was gifted, a renowned singer and faithful member of the Newark Church of Christ, and one of the lead singers of the Exciting Enchanters. Jessie served in the following benevolent ministries: singing ministry to the Sick and Shut-In, Back-to-School Supply ministry, Sick Visitation ministry, and was a Sunday Bible Class teacher.

Jessie leaves a host of unforgettable songs for us to listen to. Jessie, her late husband, Willie Ben Johnson, her late sister, Gussie Gillis, the late brother Otis Coney, the late sister Diane Lawton and sister Everleen Wright founded the Gospel Group, The Exciting Enchanters. Additional members later added to the group were Pamela Askew, Ray Wright, Terrence Best and Portia Askew. They traveled all over the East Coast and visited other states such as Texas, Chicago, Florida, Alabama, North Carolina and many other places singing praises to the Lord.

Jessie's signature songs were: Precious Lord; God is Good; and I'm Pressing On. She was also known for her Mac & Cheese and Collard Greens, and was a trophy winning bowler.

Jessie departed this life on the morning of Saturday, April 23, 2022 while at Saint Barnabas Hospital, Livingston, NJ.
