

Michael along with his three siblings attended elementary school P.S. 208, then Myer Levin J.H.S and finally Samuel J. Tilden High School. Around 1987 the entire family moved to Saint Albans Queens New York. In Queens Michael attended Jamacia High School. At Jamacia High School, he would not only graduate with his high school diploma but would meet the love of his life, the late Gaylette Tanya Drummonds while attending classes for the gifted. Their love would produce a precious son, Michael Victor Girard III, born on December 20th, 1991. Michael absolutely loved and adored both Gaylette and their son; and was overcome with grief when Gaylette suddenly died on July 13th 2001, in car accident while at work.

In 1999 to the time of his passing, Michael was employed with Local Union 28, as a Sheetmetal worker and Welder.
