Obituary

Mary Naomi Brissett, the third of six children, was born on January 29, 1934, to Arthur and Maudlin Brissett at the Victoria Jubilee Hospital, Kingston, Jamaica. While she was the third in birth line, she outlived all her siblings. She began her rest in Jesus on May 8, 2022.

Mary, Aunt May May as she was affectionately called, was loved by many. She was a strong, hardworking and God-fearing woman. While in Jamaica, Mary found gainful employment in the garment industry. She was a faithful member of the Rollington Town Seventh Day Adventist church in Jamaica and was an active member of the choir for many years. In the late seventies, Mary immigrated to the United States where she worked in home care.

Despite her inability to attend church, Mary's faith remained strong and vibrant. Mary loved to sing – something she seemed to have inherited from her mother. She could be heard singing throughout the week in preparation for the Sabbath.

All who knew her would agree that Mary was a funny, caring, loving and kind person. She would go to any length to assist anyone who needed her help. She took pleasure in helping friends and family and she performed each act of kindness with passion and enthusiasm.

Mary was predeceased by her parents Arthur and Maudlin Brissett; her four brothers George, Charles, John, and Vincent; and her sister Ruby. Now that she has finished her course, she leaves to cherish her memory, her only surviving aunt, Ruth Adams (Florida), nieces, nephews, grand nieces, grand nephews, great grand nieces and nephews, cousins, and a host of extended family members and dear friends who love and miss her dearly. When we all get to heaven, what a day of rejoicing that will be! When we all see Jesus, we'll sing and shout the victory!


While we walk the pilgrim pathway Clouds will overspread the sky; But when trav'ling days are over Not a shadow, not a sigh. [Refrain]
