<u>Obituary</u>

Gregory Chisholm was born to the late Daniel Thomas and Charlotte Chisholm in the Bronx, New York on December 31, 1971. At a very young age, Gregory developed a love for reading and would often be fed the Word of God by one of his uncles.

He attended Taft High School and then transferred to be with his best friend, Monte, at Dodge High School.

Greg was an educator and learner at heart, always developing a new level of love for reading and learning new things. He was kind to others, he always had time to answer a question or give words of wisdom, and even pray with someone no matter how small the request was. He was very inquisitive and was always immersed in the Word of God.

In 2006, Gregory became a Community Liaison at the Claremont Neighborhood Center of the Bronx, advocating throughout the community and also establishing and maintaining relationships with agency organizations. He was able to develop his public speaking gift by conducting several speaking presentation engagements at public schools and events for Community Boards 3, 4, and 5. This also prepared him for his future calling and ministry.

In 2007, he graduated from Boricua College in the Bronx, New York with a Liberal Arts Associates degree in Psychology.

He was witnessed to by one of his friends' sister, which led him to the Lord while attending The Bible Church of Christ, Inc. In 2020, Gregory attended and graduated from Theological Seminary and Biblical Institute earning his Masters degree of Theology and became an ordained missionary.

In September 2021, he was blessed to be employed by The Osborne Association working as a Re-entry Specialist and a Group and Peer Counselor working with inmates who would be reentering into society. Gregory knew his purpose was to make a difference in the lives that he connected with daily whether at work, in the residential building he lived in, at church, or even at the corner store. He always took the opportunity to pray and tell someone about the goodness of the Lord. He was definitely an evangelist.

Around February 2021, Gregory heard the voice of the Lord stating it was time to transition into where the Lord wanted him to be in that season of his life. He was then led to the doors of Dunamis Deliverance Discipleship Ministries under the leadership of Senior Pastor Marcel and Co-Pastor Ruth Langhorn. Greg served in the ministry in several capacities. He was a Gatekeeper (intercessor) and he loved to pray and war in the Spirit. He served on the security team, where he was always found smiling and greeting the guests at the door with a hug and a warm welcome. Gregory was the Outreach Specialist for the Priesthood Men's Ministry, reaching out and staying connected to men in and out of D3 and the community. He was the last to be inducted into the Core Leadership team and immediately became a part of a group of people willing and ready to help push the mission and vision of the senior leaders of the house. Greg left a lasting impression upon the Core Leaders. Greg was the epitome of a true servant in all aspects. He was also a worshiper and a praiser. Everytime he thought about where the Lord brought him from he gave God the praise. We know he is now dancing up there in heaven and worshiping his Lord and Savior.

Gregory is survived by: his mother, Charlotte Chisholm; his son, Isaiah Chisholm; along with his uncle; a host of cousins, aunts and extended family members. He will be dearly missed by his loved ones, family and friends.
