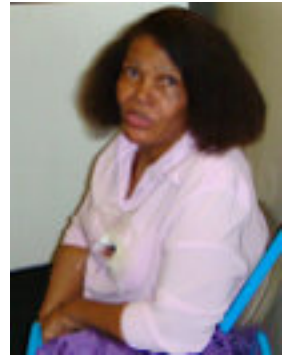

#### **Northern State Parkway - Exit 40**

(Sign: Wellwood Avenue-Pineblawn - Exit 40)

Take 110 South to Pineblawn Road. Make left onto Pineblawn Road. Continue approximately 3 miles. Pineblawn Memorial Park is located on the left, just before the L.I.R.R./Pineblawn railroad station.

#### **Southern State Parkway - Exit 36**

(Sign: Wellwood Avenue-Pineblawn - Exit 36)

**From the West:** Turn right onto Wellwood Avenue/Pineblawn Road. Continue approximately 2 miles. After crossing railroad tracks, Pineblawn Memorial Park is on the immediate right.

**From the East:** Turn left onto Wellwood Avenue/Pineblawn Road. Continue approximately 2 miles. After crossing railroad tracks, Pineblawn Memorial Park is on the immediate right.

#### **Long Island Expressway - Exit 49**

**From West:** (Sign: Exit 49S - 110 South Pineblawn-Amyville)

Take service road to third traffic light (Pineblawn Road). Turn right onto Pineblawn Road and continue approximately 3 miles. Pineblawn Memorial Park is located on the left, just before the L.I.R.R./Pineblawn railroad station.

**From the East:** (Sign: Exit 49N - 110 North Huntington)

Take exit to first traffic light, turn left onto Pineblawn Road and continue approximately 3 miles. Pineblawn Memorial Park is located on the left, just before the L.I.R.R./Pineblawn railroad station.

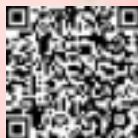
