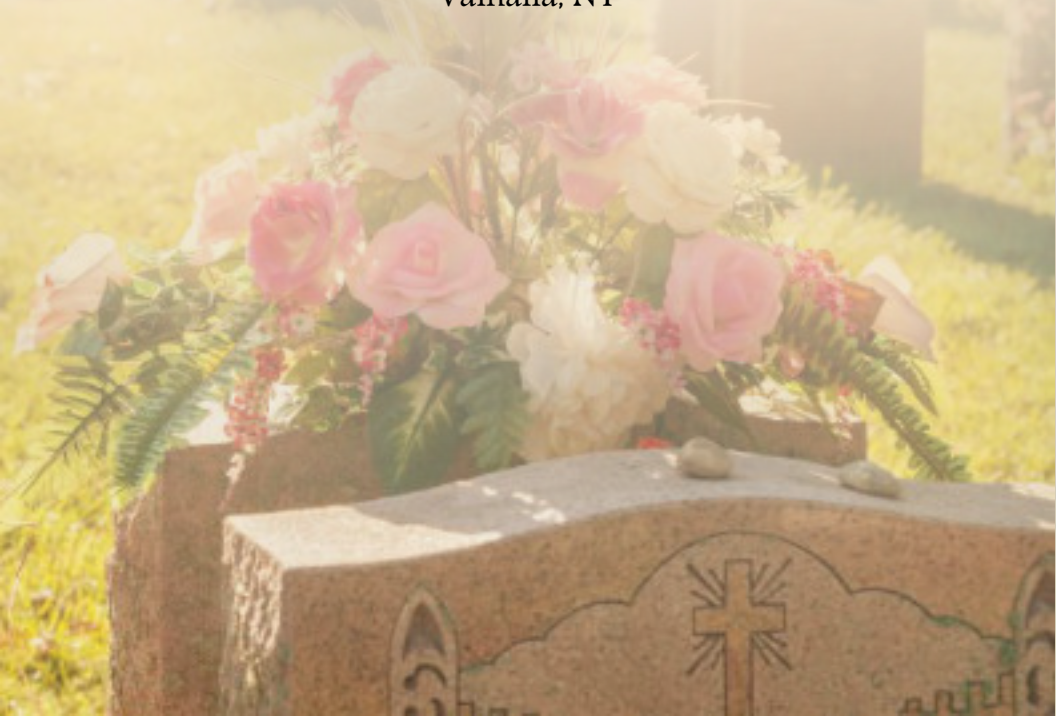

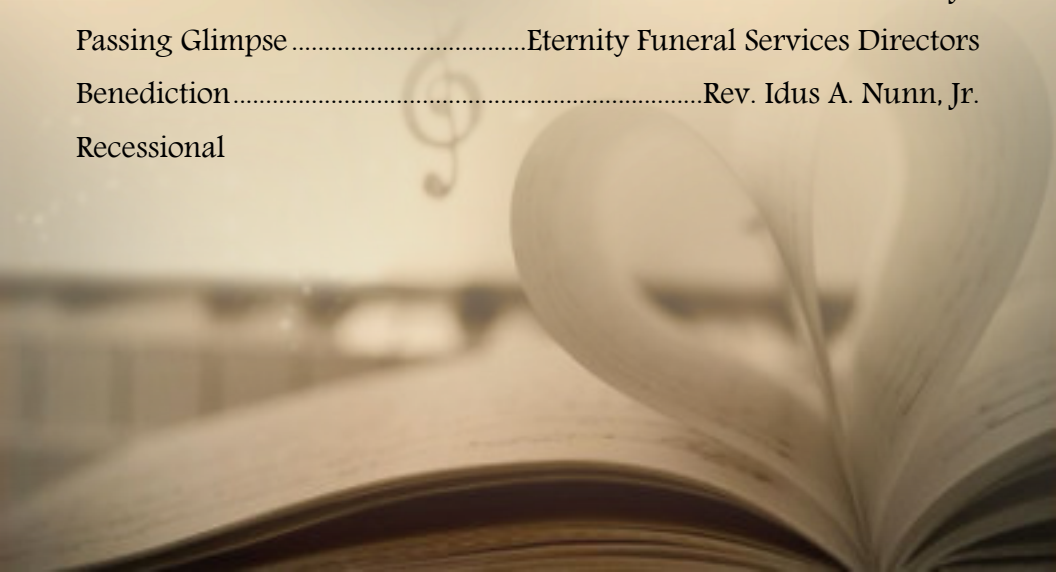

Obituary

Annette Delores Webster was born March 22, 1946, to the late Edward and Beulah Cash in Charleston, South Carolina. She departed this life on Thursday May 19, 2022, at Montefiore Medical Center Bronx, NY.

Annette was a resident of the Bronx, NY. She was educated in the Charleston South Carolina school system.

Annette Worked for the New York City Department of Human Resources for 25 years until she retired.
