Alyssa Nicole Lacewell was born on July 26, 2013, in Edison, NJ to Melissa Terry and Darren Lacewell. She brought so much joy to her family, especially her mom as her youngest and only daughter. ALYSSA lived in Rahway, NJ and was a 3rd grader at Grover Cleveland Elementary School.

Although ALYSSA only lived eight years, her charm, wit, and "grown-up" personality captured the hearts of everyone she came in contact with. If asked, every one of her family members could share something cleverly "off-the-cuff" that ALYSSA said or did that put her in class all by herself as a little girl way ahead of her time.

ALYSSA loved going to school, riding her bike, and doing hair. She was a beautician in her own right. She adored her family and loved spending time with them.

In September of 2021, ALYSSA was diagnosed with a rare brain tumor, typically found in children. For 8 months, ALYSSA showed her family, friends, doctors, and hospital staff her relentless bravery and strength through countless tests, scans, procedures, surgeries and more. Even on days when she felt overwhelmingly weak and tired, she pushed herself to attend and complete her treatments.

On May 21, 2022, ALYSSA lost her battle with the tumor, but won the battle over her sickness and suffering. She peacefully slipped away to be with the Lord whom she loved. Her love for Christ was evident in her prayer life, her praise and in her worship; especially accompanied by her favorite song which she played repeatedly "WayMaker."
