Pedro Flores, Jr.

Pedro Flores was born on November 21, 1965 at St, Mary's Hospital in Brooklyn, New York to Pedro Flores and Maria Flores (nee Cruz). He lived in various sections of Brooklyn attending St. Mark's Lutheran School, St. Francis Cabrini and August Martin High School. Pedro then worked at American Broadcasting Company (ABC) for many years and received many promotions. It was here that he met his future wife, Faye Cargill and they were married on August 17, 1991. They purchased their first home soon after on Clarendon Road in the East Flatbush section of Brooklyn, seven blocks away from Faye's childhood home. In April, 1993, they welcomed the birth of their first child, Christopher James. Pedro then made a career change to Information Technology and was hired by PriceWaterhouseCoopers as an IT Administrator in which he worked for seven years with increasing promotions. In 1998, they moved from their beloved Brooklyn to Morristown, New Jersey. In 2000, they welcomed the birth of their second son Peter Alexander. He continued in the IT field in various companies but he was proudest that he finally completed his desire for a college degree at Pillar College in 2012. He graduated Magna Cum Laude in Business Administration and Management. Pedro was an avid cyclist, participating in many biathlons in his youth. He also enjoyed going to the beach, grilling, gourmet cooking, fine wines, foreign movies, gardening as well as the upkeep of his lawn. He also was very handy completing many renovation projects in his home. He loved his family, hosting many gatherings. He was a great father supporting his sons in all their endeavors, but the most important aspect of Pedro was that he was a man of great faith, conducting Bible studies in his home for many years. In September, 2016 Pedro was diagnosed with Chronic Lymphocytic Leukemia (CLL). He never let that disease prevent him from living life to its fullest. Unfortunately, the disease aggressively progressed in 2022 and he went to be with the Lord on May 26, 2022. Throughout his struggle with his illness, he tried to instill hope and knew regardless if he was healed on earth or in heaven he was a winner. He is survived by his wife of thirty years Faye, his sons Christopher and Peter, his sister Belinda Aguilar, and his mom Maria Flores. He will be greatly missed by many.
