Obituary

Errol John Leamy, was born to Eric and Inez Leamy on December 25th, 1953, in Kingston, Jamaica. According to his mom, he was "the greatest Christmas gift." Errol attended Whitfield Primary School and played the trumpet in the St. Peter's Clever Crusaders Marching Band in Kingston, Jamaica. Upon arriving in New York, Errol attended a technical school in Manhattan where he graduated with top Honors. He also attended Bronx Community College then furthered his studies at Cornell University in Ithaca, NY. Upon graduating with a bachelor's degree in Computer Engineering, Errol received offers from 5 separate firms and after much consideration, he decided to accept the assignment that took him to Massachusetts.
