Fiona being the youngest of the bunch was subject to "special care" being my "mother's baby" and we all as older siblings would have to take care of her, by taking her to school, feeding her, cleaning up after her and teaching her of how to do things.

In 1995, we lost our mom, a massive loss, and Fiona who was 17 at the time, a young woman losing her mom was devastating not only to her but to all of us.

I remember and would always be grateful to "Fungie" as she was affectionately called by us, as she was my first personal assistant, she made herself available to wash and iron my clothes, have my meals prepared, on my return from overseas tours or tournaments, she would be the first to remove my dirty clothes from my suitcases ,Fiona loved to take care of people, she was my first baby sitter, she loved boy children she would take out her nephews in the afternoons for walks, and take other care of them, I remember vividly her friends were, Gary "Pipes" Jermaine and Sean those were her "boys"

After schooling Fiona went work at Uncle Eddies Home. Fiona's life took a new chapter after she meet Francis and began her own family, and they had a son, Antwone and they were later married.

In 2014 Fiona migrated to the US to begin another chapter in her life, where she lived in Irvington, NJ and worked at Roseville Manor and then Home Watch until the time of her passing.

There is no doubt that Fiona's portion on God's earth was to take care of people both young and old, she leaves to mourn: Husband Francis, son Antwone, Father, brothers, sister, nieces, nephews, cousins, in laws and friends.
