to thy great faithfulness, mercy, and love. [Refrain]

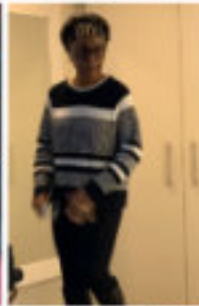
