Now this is just what Heaven means to me. (Chorus)

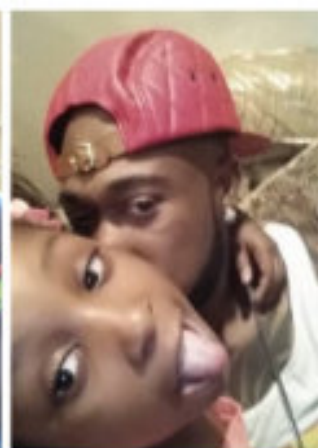
