Louis Paul King, affectionately known as "Pops" was born in the Ginger Hall, St. Thomas, Jamaica West Indies, on October 10, 1947, to Lurline Bell and Wilfred King (deceased). He was the fourth of nine children, four of whom preceded him in death: Edith King, Norma King, Peaches Bell, and Anthony Mahony.

Louis attended Bathe Primary School. Following his years of education, he went on to do farming and carpentry.

Louis was blessed with six children, one of whom preceded him in death: Michael.

Louis immigrated to the United States of America in 1982. In the US, he worked with Nestle Industries as a forklift operator for many years until the company relocated. He then went to work in construction until he retired. He became a naturalized citizen in September of 1999. He was an ordained Deacon in his church.

Louis met and married the former Gloria Kerr on May 16, 2001. They were graced with 21 years of love and devotion until his transition on July 8, 2022.

Louis is survived by his wife Gloria King, mother Lurline Bell, children Herma, Jacob, Solomon, Paul and Donna. Brothers Arnold, Neville, Willington and sister Maureen Grant, 17 grandchildren and 8 great-grandchildren, a host of stepchildren, nieces, nephews, friends and well-wishers.
