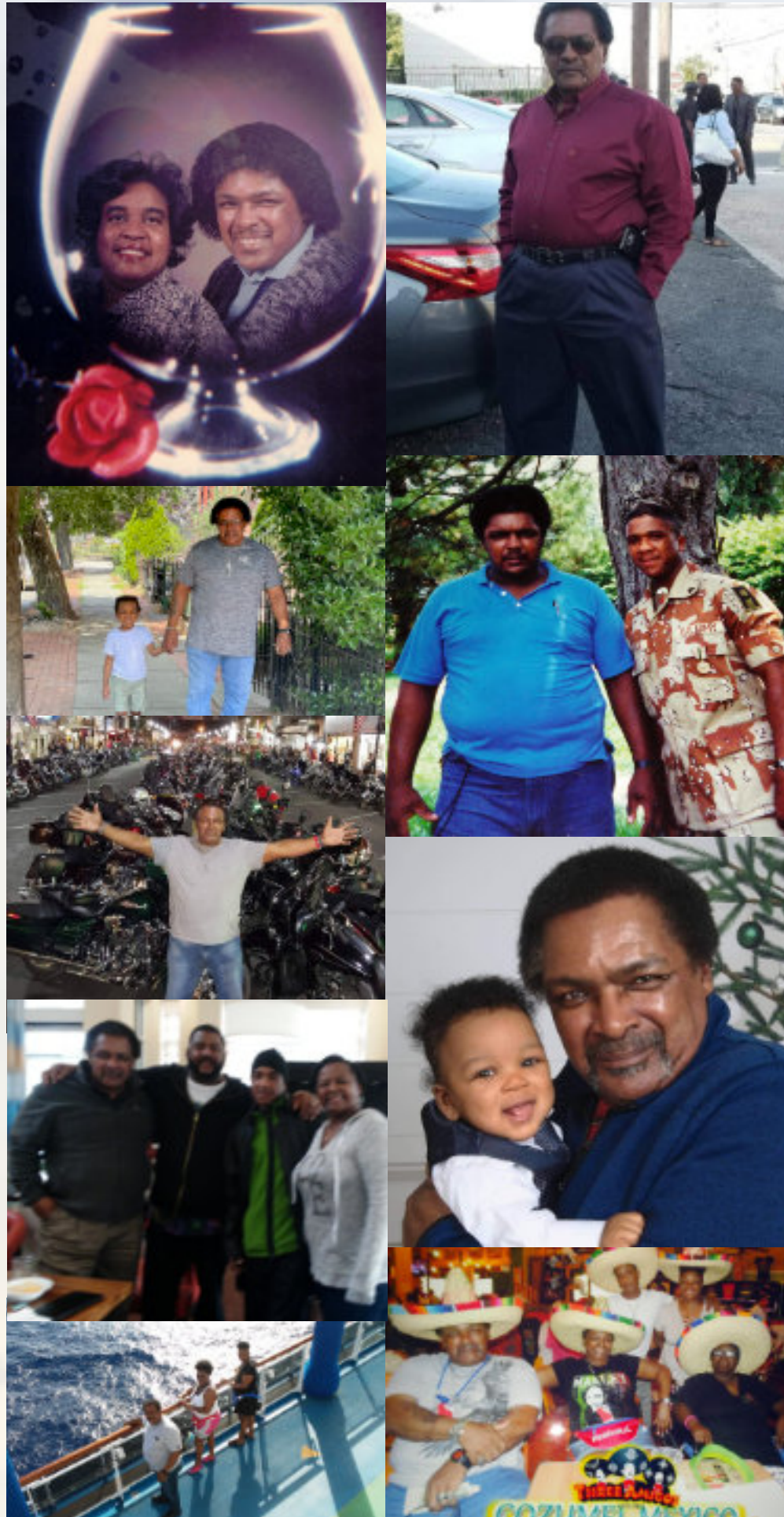
Obituary
