Beatrice was a Showroom Model during the 1950's & 1960's she attended Dental School in Newark, NJ where she received her certificate as a Dental Technician in 1973. She was united in holy matrimony to John Truesdale who preceded her in death.

Sister Beatrice Truesdale joined Unity Missionary Church under the leadership of her father in 1957. She was one of the founding members.
