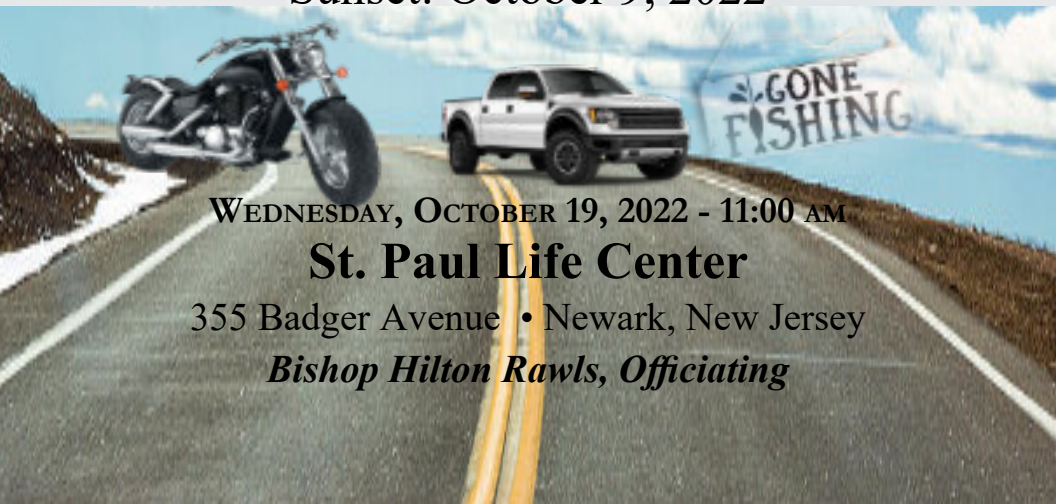

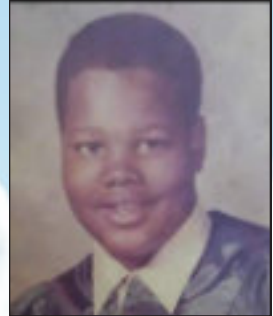
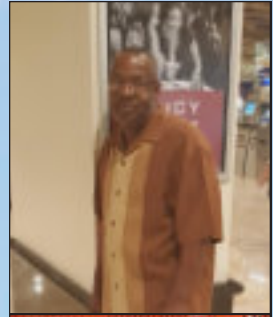
# Remembering
