Kyle had a soft spot for kids, especially his cousins Kyra and Daniel.... helping them tie shoelaces and in the winter, button up sweaters and jackets for school. Then, when his nephews came along, he helped he helped them in many little ways too. His niece Amariah came along a few years later and she was the joy of his life. She spent a short time with him in July 2022 and it was a happy time for them both.

Kyle married Petronella Timothy in 2009 and despite the trials of marriage he loved her deeply. On September 12, 2017, they had a son, Kyon Gonzalez who immediate became his pride and joy. Sadly, Kyon lived only 11 short days. His grief over the loss of his son was not yet assuaged before, on 15 June 2022 his wife passed away. He spent his last days consumed by grief; but he always remained the same loving caring person, and we are grateful for having had him for 36 years.
