## **Obituary**

Mark grew up in East Orange, New Jersey, yet attended and graduated from Montclair High where he was known as a "stand out" athlete in several sports, especially football. After graduating from Montclair High School in 1992, Mark attended Texas A & M University in Fort Worth, Texas where he studied for two years. Missing his family dearly, Mark returned to New Jersey to be near them.

Shortly afterwards, he met and fell in love with former wife Taliah S. Elder and her daughter Joi Hamm. The couple were married and out of that union three children were born, Janelle, Jawuan and Jada Elder. As the family grew, they relocated to Richmond, Virginia.

Mark was employed as a long distant driver in the Trucking Industry for many years, which provided for his family until they reached adulthood and became self-sufficient. The couple became grandparents to his only grandchild Saniya Marie Marrow age 3 which he affectionately called "Sunny Dough" the apple of his eye. The family lived in Richmond until the marriage ended and he returned to Montclair to begin a new chapter in his life.

Mark often attended Divinity Missionary Church in East Orange with his mother Carolyn, although he was not a member, he would sometimes attend services by himself demonstrating his strong faith in God by sitting in the front rows making his presence known.

Mark was currently employed by Montclair Township in Montclair, NJ, until a fatal accident ended his life on March 27, 2025. He will always be remembered for his affectionate smile and warm charm.
